## Rehoboth McKinley Christian Health Care Services Announces Leadership Change

**GALLUP, N.M. – October 5, 2023** – The Rehoboth McKinley Christian Health Care Services (RMCHCS) [Board of Trustees](#) has announced the resignation of Robert A. Whitaker as Chief Executive Officer, effective October 29, 2023.

Serving as CEO since April of 2022, Whitaker has helped improve hospital relations with the medical staff and community, while setting a foundation for continued improvement. He also led a key strategic initiative toward the hospital's conversion to critical access hospital (CAH) status by working closely with local and state officials on funding opportunities for hospital improvements.

The Board has initiated a search and will begin the process of replacing the CEO next week.
